Irrigation Team Policy Approved at Community Meeting December 3, 2017

The Community agrees to form an Irrigation Team to manage community water use. The community empowers the Irrigation Team to manage all community water use and work with other groups/teams/committees, like Green Team and Villages, on how water is used. The Irrigation Team's authority includes, but is not limited by, the power to:

- a. Prohibit new irrigation extensions of any community water.
- b. Significantly reduce irrigation. Irrigate only the lawn and the garden. Citrus would rely on greywater, cistern and hand-watering. Hand-watering means using buckets to water and not walking away from the hose when watering.
- c. Remove the irrigation timers from all irrigation standpipes in the community.
- d. Cap the hose bib on the East side of the workshop, which is metered at domestic water rates.
- e. Put a lock on the 2 cisterns by citrus spigots so that they wouldn't be opened to drain out.
- f. Get quotes from irrigation companies on eliminating our entire irrigation system and installing a simple irrigation system with one valve that controls the lawn and one valve that controls the garden.
- g. Ensure village common areas are hand-watered from irrigation spigots only.
- h. Close the lawn area between the Common House patio and the sidewalk by turning off irrigation zone #4 permanently."
