The laundry facilities are for use by all SC residents and their guests. Below you will find some basic rules of use, as well as guidelines that keep things running smoothly.

RULES

- Residents may not bring outside laundry products (detergent, dryer sheets, fabric softeners, etc...) into the CH laundry room.
- Only those products approved by CHIC and provided by the COA for all residents may be used and/or stored in the laundry room.
- The laundry room is closed for maintenance for 2 hours each week; currently 10am-noon every Sunday. Please do not attempt to use the facility during this time and refrain from leaving your personal laundry items (clothes and baskets) in the room during the maintenance period.
- Please remove clothes promptly from the laundry room when they are done
 drying. Any clothes that remain in the laundry room will be placed in the "lost and
 found" during the regularly scheduled weekly maintenance.

Helpful Hints:

- There is a system of magnets on the side of the washers that allows residents to keep the flow of laundering going without having to be present throughout the entire process.
- When you place a load of laundry in the washer, be sure to use the magnets
 provided to leave drying instructions on the front of the washer. That way if
 someone gets to your finished load before you do they will know what to do with
 your clothes.
- Please do not remove clothing from the washers that is not yours unless (1) there
 is a dryer available for the clothes to be transferred to or (2) the load has been
 marked "no dryer, basket please"
- Clean as you go (supplies are kept on a laundry room shelf)
- Use the amber glass bottle marked "Washer Boots" to spray and wipe down the rubber door boots of the washer before and/or after use of machine
- Use the amber glass bottle marked "Counters and Surfaces" to wipe down the counter whenever you notice soap scum or any "residue" left on the counter
- If you notice that the dirty hamper for laundry room cleaning rags is full, please put them in the washer. Use the magnets labeled "laundry room rags" to place on the front of the washer.
